

Canon Powershot A530 Camera

Downloading photos to your computer on Windows XP

1. Turn on your **Canon Powershot A530** by pressing the **ON/OFF** button located on top of the camera. A green power light now turns on.

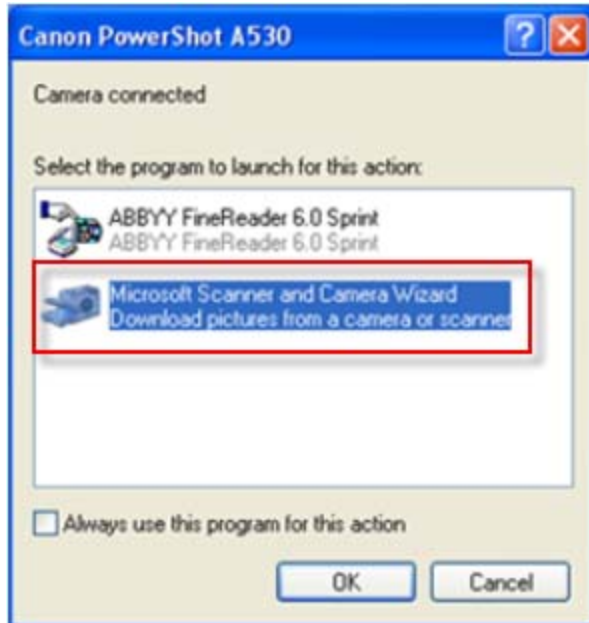
2. Locate the plastic USB connector cover situated on the left side of the camera facing the LCD monitor.
3. Pull the cover outwards at the bottom end and slide it sideways to reveal the camera's digital USB interface.
4. Now connect the Universal Serial Bus (USB) cable included with your Powershot A530 starter kit, by attaching the smaller USB connector to the camera's USB interface and the larger connector to a computer USB port.

A dialog box now confirms the camera is connected.

(**Note:** If no dialog box appears, ensure the camera is turned on and properly connected to the computer. Check that the green power light beside the ON/OFF button is lit).



5. Select the **Microsoft Scanner and Camera Wizard** to highlight it, then click **OK**.

The **Scanner and Camera Wizard** now launches.

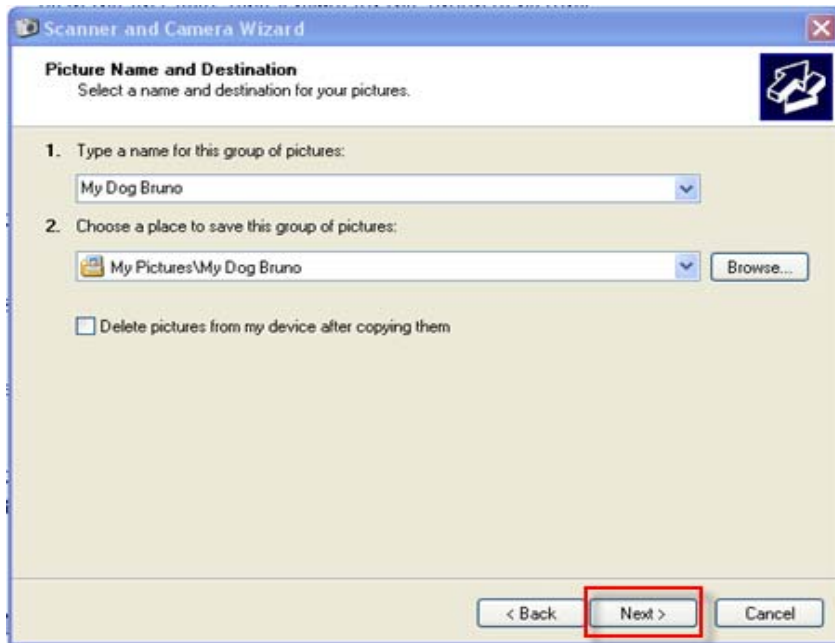
Windows XP now detects the **Powershot A530** camera.

6. Click **Next** to continue.

The **Name and Destination** fields now appear.

7. In the first field, type a name for this group of pictures.
8. In the second field, choose a location to which to save your pictures.

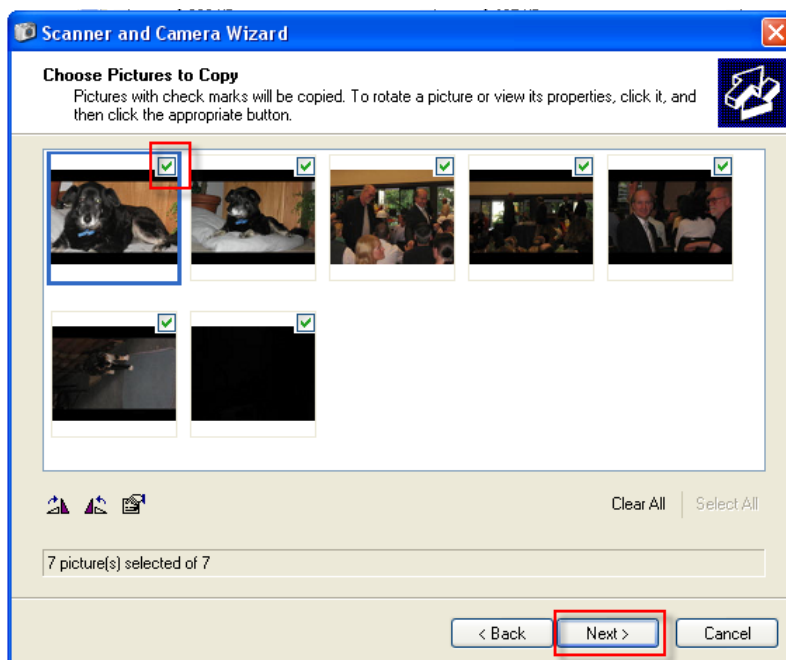


Photos are saved to the **My Pictures** folder by default.

To save to another location, select **Browse**, then select the desired folder.

Your photos now appear with check marks. Only photos with check marks will be copied.

To deselect a photo, left-click the check mark beside it.

The computer now starts downloading all your selected pictures from the **Powershot A530** to the chosen computer location.

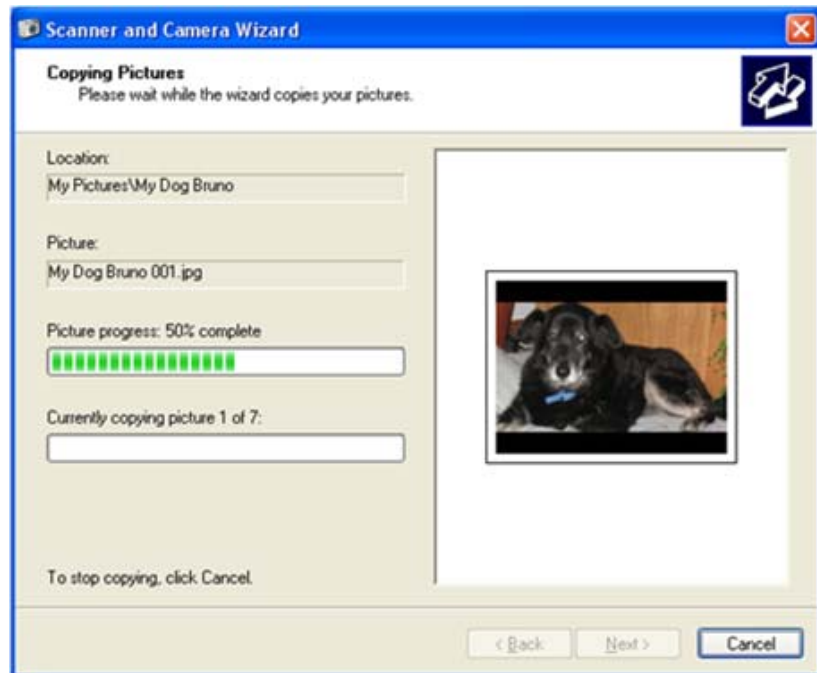

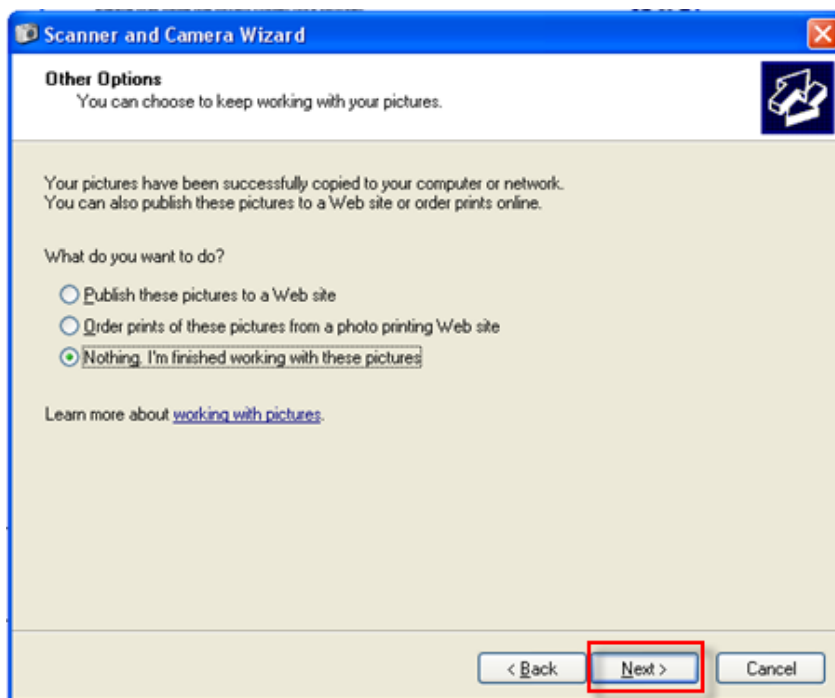
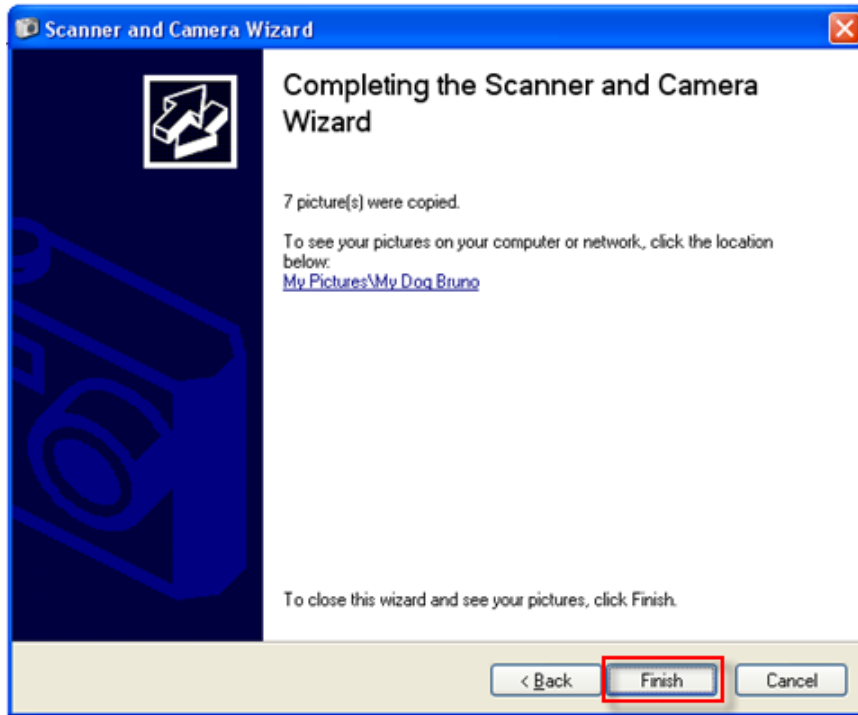

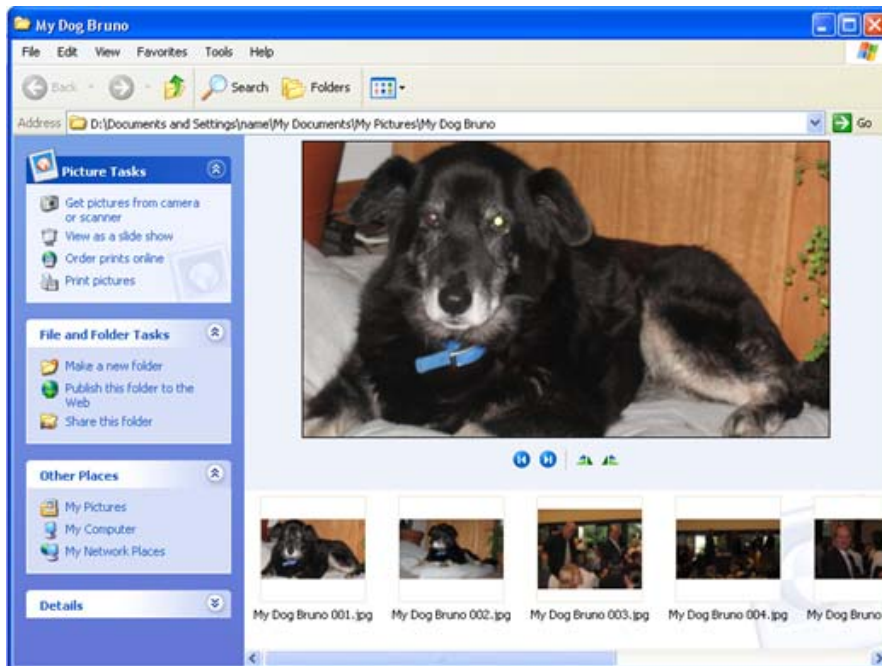
The **Scanner and Camera Wizard** confirms your pictures have been copied successfully.
